Our History

As Mennonites, we stand in a long tradition. Our history has its roots in the year 1525 when the Anabaptist movement developed along side the Swiss reformation. The name "Mennonites" is derived from Menno Simons, a Dutch priest who assembled various groups of Anabaptists.

Because State and Church feared that they would lose their monopoly and authority, Anabaptists were persecuted for many years. As a result, numerous Mennonite families made their new home in the Palatinate region as well as in North America.

The Mennonite Church at the Weierhof was founded in 1682 and currently counts 300 baptized members.


Today, there are 1.6 million Mennonites in 80 countries worldwide.


Active Involvement
